

Review After Visit Summary and Notes in MyChart

Following your visit your providers notes as well as your after visit summary will be made available in MyChart.

1. Log into your MyChart account.
2. Select **Visits**.
3. In the **Past Visits** section locate the encounter you'd like to see.
4. Select the **View Notes** or **View After Visit Summary** option.
