

Ribbon Snuggler Used in the Emergency Room and on Pediatics.


Materials needed:

Fleece or other soft fabric Non-fraying ribbons in assorted colors and textures

- 1. Cut two (2) pieces of fabric into a 10inch square with rounded corners.
- 2. Cut eight (8) pieces of assorted ribbon to 4-inch lengths.
- 3. Fold ribbon pieces in half with right side out to produce a loop. Stitch ribbon pieces to the right side of one of the squares with ribbon fold toward the center of the fabric and raw edges of the ribbon and fabric together.
- 4. Put the second fabric square on top of the ribbon square with right sides of fabric together. Stitch together, leaving an opening to turn it right side out.
- 5. Turn snuggler right side out. The ribbon loops will stick out like a sun with rays going out.
- 6. Top stitch all the way around, tucking in the seam allowance on the opening.
