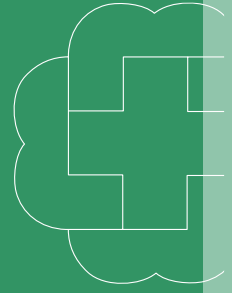


Bronson MyChart Bedside for Inpatients



Bedside in MyChart Mobile

Bedside in MyChart Mobile is an easy way for patients and their families to access Bedside features on any personal iOS or Android mobile device, using the MyChart app.

When a patient in the hospital opens the MyChart Mobile app, they see a “Your Hospital Stay” page with features tailored to the point of care they are at right now. Here, they can see pertinent information and activities related to their stay.

Family members with proxy access can also use their personal devices or log in from a computer to stay informed when they are unable to be at the hospital in person.

Features in Bedside in MyChart Mobile

In the MyChart Mobile app, patients and proxy users can see:

- The treatment team, with bios and role descriptions for each person.
- Patient-facing education. They can also document understanding.
- Inpatient medications and lab results with patient-friendly wording and privacy settings.
- Hospital health issues, in addition to existing issues from before they were admitted.
- The patient schedule, including medication times, nursing tasks, surgeries, and more.
- Dining menus and ordering options with third-party integration.
- Inpatient video visits using Epic video visits.
- Your own apps, websites, and other integrated content that you add to Bedside.

In addition, they can use these communication and documentation features:

- Inpatient questionnaires, including patient-entered clinical documentation.
- E-signature forms. No signature pad needed.
- Bedside chat, for non-urgent messages to the care team.
- Non-urgent requests.
